DELIVERING LOCAL PROJECTS IN EMSWORTH

We continue to fund local projects through a Levy on new housing. The money raised has helped to fund medical equipment for the Emsworth Surgery, the Emsworth Men's Shed and Emsworth Museum. Richard also recognises the lack of facilities for young people in north Emsworth and has been working with YMCA on proposals to develop an Early Years, Youth and Community Centre at Redlands Grange, helping to secure a £200,000 CIL grant from the Council.



WORKING TO PROTECT LONG COPSE LANE

Over the last five years Richard has showed his commitment to protect green spaces such as Long Copse Lane from unwanted development. He has brought together residents' groups from across Emsworth and beyond to work together to oppose plans for over 200 houses, and ensure that this area can continue to be enjoyed by walkers, dog walkers, cyclists and horse riders.



IMPROVING OUR PLAY AREAS

Outdoor play areas are important for young families and in Emsworth we are fortunate to have a good range of facilities at Horndean Road, Southleigh Road and Hampshire Farm Meadow which have benefited from investment and new equipment. Richard will press for continued funding in our play areas and open spaces so these remain valued facilities for all.
