## IMPROVED SERVICES ON THE SEAFRONT FOR 2022

Havant Borough Council in partnership with Norse will be delivering improved services to users of the Hayling Island Seafront in 2022. This includes extended opening hours of the public toilets which will be supported by an increased cleaning schedule. New bigger bins that will be collected by a new electric vehicle. To support this the current tourist office at Beachlands will become Seafront HQ with duty managers available onsite 7 days a week.
